1. **DO NOT** send your child to school if your child is sick.
2. Follow health department protocols when traveling.
3. Provide an appropriate mask (N-95 & KN-95 are the best) and teach your child how to wear it properly.
4. Contact me if your child tests positive for Covid or if your child has been in close contact with a Covid positive person.
5. I encourage you to get your child vaccinated if your child is eligible.
