

## Principal Green News:

Welcome to all our returning and new families! St. John's is beginning its 145th year of offering a quality education.

Below are some important items for your attention.

- **Montrose Avenue Resurfacing** - This project began on Wednesday, 08/25. It is scheduled to be completed by the end of September. I urge you to not drop off or pick up on Montrose during the construction. Please use the school parking lot.
- **School Office Carpeting** - The school office is scheduled to be carpeted this Saturday and Sunday. All offices had to remove a large amount of material to enable the carpet to be installed. Please be patient with us as we will need to set up the office on Monday.
- **Early Childhood Parents** - Pre-School, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten parents are allowed to bring their children into the building next week.
- **Tardies** - Tardies were not assessed this week and will also not be assessed next week. I will wait to see how the Montrose Avenue resurfacing is going before determining when tardies will begin to be assessed. Beginning next week the gates to the playground will be closed and locked at 8:30am. If the gates are locked students will need to go to Door #1 on Montrose Ave. to be admitted into the building.
- **Covid - 19 Vaccine Eligible Students** - I encourage families of eligible students (ages 12 and up) to get their child vaccinated. I also ask that families of students who are vaccinated send me a copy of their vaccine card.
- **Extended Care** - Candy Lawler is our Extended Care Director. Candy has served in various roles at St. John's and is a parent of St. John's alumni. A schedule for Extended Care is being developed and will be shared with you next week. Any child not picked up by 3:30pm will be sent to Extended Care.
- **Extended Care Workers** - We are still in need of additional workers for Extended Care. Please speak to me if you are interested.
- **Candy Sale** - The *World's Finest Candy Sale* kicks off next week. Forms were sent home this week. Please consider participating in the sale. Profits from the sale benefit all of St. John's students.
- **Tuition and Fees Payments** - Education Fees were due on August 15. If you have not done so, please pay these fees. The first tuition payment along with the PTL fee is due on September 15. St. John's Board of Christian Education established a strict tuition collection policy that I am required to follow. Do not allow yourself to get behind on tuition payments.
- ♦ **Financial Aid** - Scholarships have been awarded to several families. The Financial Aid Committee will meet again soon to award additional scholarships to families that have applied. Scholarships are not applied to TADS accounts until the office receives a thank you letter to the funding sources of the scholarship. If you receive scholarships from multiple sources, you must write a thank you letter to each source before the scholarship is applied to your account.
