



St. John's Lutheran School

dress code

All clothing worn by St. John's students should fit properly and be clean, neat, in good repair, suitable for the weather, and not showing any undergarments. As a Lutheran school, standards for apparel must support the philosophy and goals of our school. The principal or homeroom teacher reserves the right to decide whether the dress/appearance of a student is in agreement with the uniform code and appropriate for school.

PRE-SCHOOL AND PRE-KINDERGARTEN:

All students must wear clothing that is clean, neat, and in good repair.

KINDERGARTEN – 8th GRADE:

TOPS: Plain collared polo, dress shirt with sleeves, or a St. John's tee shirt. Official scout uniforms may be worn on meeting days.

OUTERWEAR: St. John's royal blue or grey sweatshirt with our logo, or a plain navy or white sweater or sweatshirt.

FOOTWEAR: Fully enclosed flat shoes only - with socks or tights. NO sandals, flip flops, crocs or boots of any kind are allowed in the classroom.

ACCESSORIES: Hair must be well groomed, and not hanging in the face – (naturally occurring color only). For boys, the hair must be above the collar. Girls may wear stud earrings. No make-up, perfume, cologne, or fragrant lotions are to be used. Tattoos (including temporary) are not allowed.

BOTTOMS:

- Kindergarten – 5th Grade: Solid navy blue pants, knee length shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, or uniform dress (no skinny pants or athletic pants). Shorts, tights or leggings must be worn under skirts/dresses.
- 6th – 8th Grade: Solid khaki pants, knee length shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, or uniform dress (no skinny pants). Shorts, tights or leggings must be worn under skirts/dresses.

GYM: Students in all grades must have gym shoes that are kept at school. Grades 5th -8th must wear gym uniforms purchased from St. John's.
