GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

RATES

Full-Time Camp Hours: 8 AM – 3 PM

Full-Time Camp Weekly Rate: \$200 each week per camper

Part-Time Camp Weekly Rates:

- 5 half days \$160 each week per camper (8am 11:30am)
- 3 full days (Tues, Wed., Thurs.) \$160 each week per camper (8am - 3pm)

Registration Fee for both part-time and full-time is a one time, non-refundable fee of \$65 for each camper.

*Please note, due to staffing, part-time days are set days: Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

THERE WILL BE NO CAMP JULY 1ST - 5TH SO THAT ALL CAMPERS AND STAFF CAN ENJOY THE HOLIDAY WEEK.

SIBLING RATES (sibling rates are for full-time campers only)

2nd Child Full-Time: \$180 / week 3rd Child: \$150 / week

Payments can be made online or by check. (Please note, there is a processing fee for online payments).

All Fees are Non-Refundable

CAMP OPTIONS:

Eagles Summer Camp will run for a total of 7 weeks this summer.

- The FIRST SESSION will run for 3 weeks, June 10 June 28.
- The SECOND SESSION will run for 4 weeks, July 8 August 2.

There will be no camp on July 1 - 5.

PAYMENT OPTION 1: FULL PAYMENT FOR ALL 7 WEEKS

Payment for all 7 camp sessions by May 31st.

PAYMENT OPTION 2: TWO PAYMENT INSTALLMENTS

- Session ONE Payment 1 due May 31st for the first 3 weeks of camp
- Session TWO Payment 2 due June 24th for the last 4 weeks of camp

All payments must be made *before* your child begins each camp session.

Camp payments should be made online or paid to the office by check. <u>Refunds are not</u> <u>given for absences or cancellations.* Camp registration and camp payments are</u> <u>non-refundable.</u>

PAYMENT DETAILS:

An email with a link will be sent out to registered campers AFTER March 15th. You will then have the opportunity to confirm your weeks of camp and pay for the first session.

Full-time & part-time campers for SESSION ONE can choose to enroll in ANY OR ALL of the 3 weeks. Payment amount depends on the number of weeks enrolled and is <u>DUE BY May 31st.</u>

Full-time & part-time campers for SESSION TWO can choose to enroll in ANY OR ALL of the 4 weeks. Payment amount depends on the number of weeks enrolled and is <u>DUE BY JUNE 24th.</u>

Campers for SESSION ONE & SESSION TWO (7 WEEKS) that would like to pay in full, have the option to pay the whole amount by May 31st. FULL-TIME FOR ALL 7 WEEKS: \$1470 / PART-TIME FOR ALL 7 WEEKS: \$1120

*Sibling discounts are given to campers enrolled full-time.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

BEHAVIOR

Our desire is to have a fun and engaging camp environment for all campers! All campers will need to abide by camp rules and must be able to follow our routine / schedule. If your child has special needs or challenges, please indicate that on the registration form. We do not have 1:1 help, Title services or special education services available during summer camp.

Behaviors that may result in immediate dismissal include but are not limited to:

• Any action that could threaten or pose a direct threat to the physical/emotional safety of the child, other children, or staff

- Fighting
- Possession of a weapon of any kind
- Vandalism or destruction of school property or property of others
- Sexual misconduct
- •Biting

•Refusal to cooperate or comply with camp staff and/or camp rules

If at any time a camper is unable to comply with our camp rules, policies or procedures, they may be at risk of dismissal from summer camp without refund.

CLOTHING & TOWELS

Please provide an extra change of clothes for your child to keep at camp. Each child must bring swimwear and towel to camp during the week for water play. Girls should wear a one-piece swimsuit, no bikinis please. All personal belongings should be clearly labeled with your child's name. Any used or wet swimwear, towels, and clothing will be sent home each day and should be returned, clean, the following day.

Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for outdoor play. Children may wear t-shirts, shorts, and comfortable loose-fitting clothing for play. Campers should wear clothing that is easy to button / zip independently. We ask that each camper bring an extra set of clothing to keep at camp.

OTHER PERSONAL BELONGINGS

The camp is not liable for any toys or electronics that are brought to camp. **Please keep personal belongings at home, unless otherwise noted for a special day.** If your child brings in a personal item, they will be asked to take it back home.

FOOD

Full day campers are expected to bring their own lunch each day. **Please provide your child with a healthy lunch and at least 2 snacks.** We will be active throughout the day and include a lunch break, morning snack break, and afternoon snack break. We are unable to refrigerate or heat up food, so make sure to pack a thermos to keep hot food warm and an ice pack to keep cold food cool. Please provide your child with a water bottle daily (labeled with their name). No soda or candy, please. Be mindful of nut allergies when packing your child's lunch and snacks.

Half day campers should bring a snack, they will be dismissed before lunch.

DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURES

Parents/Legal Guardians will be required to sign their child in and out of camp and record the times of drop off and pick up. Please walk your child to the entrance (Door 6) and sign them in daily.

At pick-up, please ring the doorbell at Door 6 and a staff member will make sure to let you in so that you can sign-out your child. Campers will only be dismissed with individuals who are listed on the pick-up list.

Full day camp ends at 3pm. There will be one hour of Extended Care until 4pm for an additional charge. Half-day camp ends at 11:30.

The late fee for pick-up after 4pm for full day campers is \$1.00 per minute and is due before your child attends camp the next day. The late fee for half-day campers also applies for any camper picked up after 11:30am.
